Dr Amir graduated from University of Malaya in 1989 and went on to train in Paediatrics at Hospital Kuala Lumpur from 1991 and qualified as a Paediatrics specialist in 1996 with a Master of Medicine (Paediatrics). He subsequently did his Fellowship training in Leeds, UK in 1998 as a Specialist Registrar in Clinical Immunology & Allergy at the Leeds General Infirmary and St James University Hospital. Dr Amir joined Universiti Putra Malaysia (UPM) in 2006 as Associate Professor in Paediatrics and Clinical Immunology at the Faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences, and 2009 was appointed the Head of Department of Paediatrics. In 2010, he joined the Jeffrey Cheah School of Medicine and Health Sciences of Monash University Malaysia, Sunway Campus as a Clinical Associate Professor in Clinical Immunology and Paediatrics. He has been in private practice since 2011 at Pantai Hospital Kuala Lumpur (PHKL), and in 2017 pioneered the first Allergy & Immunology Centre in the private health sector of Malaysia at PHKL. Dr Amir is a Fellow of the American College of Allergy, Asthma and Immunology (ACAAI) and the American Academy of Allergy, Asthma and Immunology (AAAAI). He serves on the Editorial Board for AP Allergy, European Medical Journal and Frontiers in Allergy (Food Allergy).
