Recent advances in science and technology allow us to deal with these problems in the management of asthma.

We, the members of the APAAACI Asthma Committee, aim to collaborate in asthma research both in clinical and translational research among the researchers from participating local societies and develop better strategies to manage asthma in the Asia Pacific region. By doing this, we will publish the position paper on asthma management in the Asia Pacific region and facilitate collaborator research in the following 2-3 years.
